



# CARBON LEADERSHIP FORUM 2017-18 UPDATE

## Recent Milestones

Launched the **Carbon Smart Building Initiative**, bringing on **8 new non-profit partners** and forming a **30-person committee**

To guide the Carbon Smart Building Initiative, we outlined **9 necessary future states** and developed a **10-15 year roadmap**

Formed the **Embodied Carbon Network**, now comprising **270 building professionals** from **90 cities**

Launched a **2018 Webinar Series**, free, one-hour education courses eligible for AIA education credits

CLF Annual Forum in Boston brought together over **50 industry leaders and experts**

Published a step-by-step **LCA Practice Guide** and **LCA Technical Guidance** document (June '18)

**653 downloads** of three documents CLF published in 2017: The Time Value of Carbon, Embodied Carbon Benchmark Study, and LCA Model Specifications V1

Positioned to **inform research-based embodied carbon policy** advising WA state lawmakers during development of the **Buy Clean Washington Act**

Organized sessions at **Green-build, Living Futures**, and **AIA '18**, reaching over **300 attendees**

Developed plans for two upcoming events: **Build Positive: A Carbon Smart Summit & Party** (June, NYC) and the **Carbon Smart Building Conference** (Sept., San Francisco)
